Did you know?

Skanska's site cabins are Eco-Cabins that include energy saving features such as enhanced insulation, double glazing, low energy light fittings, low wattage hand dryers and dual flush toilets.

This is all part of Skanska's drive to be the greenest constructor in the world.

The School site activities coming up for the rest of November and December will include:

- Installation of pre-cast concrete planks to form the floor levels
- Cladding to start including brickwork and glazing throughout the site
- Underfloor heating to progress on the south wing ground floor and north wing ground floor
- Flat roofing to start on the south wing

The College site activities coming up for the rest of November and December will include:

- Final ground floor concrete slab to be poured
- First floor concrete slabs to progress
- Roof slab to be poured
